LET'S MAKE A SAILOR PAPER CHAIN!

Read all these instructions before you begin.

For best results print on to plain card or coloured card!


- 1. Cut out all the pieces on these pages.
- 2. Glue each 'glue' tab. Then roll up the first strip to make a link / circle.
- 3. Insert the next strip into the circle and press each end together to make another link / circle.
- 4. Continue until you have made as many links as you like resulting in a chain!
- 5. Attach 'Boat A' to a link facing horizontally. Stick each copy of 'Boat A' either side. The Boat A tab' needs to attach to each of the boats at the top.


- 6. Let's do the same with 'Boat B'! Find the link of the other end of the chain (another horizontal one) and attach each copy of 'Boat Bs' to either side of the link / circle.
- 7. Take the 'Boat B tab' and stick it to the top of each boat to combine the two boat pieces together.


If you would like more sailors to stick on to your chain, simply print another copy of the boats page and attach on any horizontal link!
