Each morning you will be greeted at the door by members of staff from Pre-School and Reception who will ensure that your child enters our building safely. They will record any messages that need to be passed onto your Key Person as they may not be available to speak to you at that time. Should you require a phone call to discuss an important matter, this will happen once the children are in and settled.

Our Day

- We will open our double doors from 8:40am until 8:55am. Anyone arriving after 8:55am will need to come to the main entrance.
- The day will begin with children gathering for Family Group Time with their Key Person. They will plan their day and reflect on what learning has taken place the day before.
- Children will then go off to play. Members of staff are there to facilitate and document the learning that takes place.
- Our morning children must be collected promptly at 11:40am. Please come in via the main entrance.
- If any of our morning Pre-School children are staying for lunch, the lunchtime session ends at 12:15pm
- Our afternoon session for Pre-School begins at 12:15pm.
- At the end of the session, children will gather in their Family Groups to review their day.
- At 3pm, the gates to the main yard and our doors will be opened for you to collect your child from our double doors.

- We fundraise every term to cover the costs of enhancements to our provision.
- Please telephone school to let us know if your child is going to be absent. Ideally, this should happen before 9am.
- If your child has sickness or diarrhoea, they must not return to EYFS until 48 hours after the last incident.
- Please ensure all items (including shoes!) are named. This way we can ensure that items are given to the correct children.
- Please provide spare clothes (in a clearly named bag) that can remain on your child's peg. Accidents do happen and children feel more comfortable when wearing their own clothes.
- If your child still requires nappies, please provide nappies, wipes and nappy bags in a clearly labelled bag.
- Please ensure that the contact details we have in school are up to date in case of emergencies.
- Children will access outdoor Forest School Learning one session each week. This will be led by our outdoor specialists. We will let you know when the session is and give further details of what this entails.

We are here to help you. Please don't hesitate to arrange an appointment with your Key Person to discuss any issues that may affect your child.
